Any other fundraising activity where students are needed. There are also many parent volunteer opportunities throughout the year. Costumes, hair and makeup, ushers, flower sales and concession sales at the shows are among the many areas that volunteers are needed.

Financial aid may be partially or fully revoked if student does not participate in the fundraisers. For example, missing one fundraiser (out of 4) could result in a scholarship reduction of 25% of the student's total scholarship.

Parents (or other family members) of students receiving scholarship are required to participate as active members in support of the choir and volunteer at one or more of these activities. Please indicate your preferences and you will be contacted by the committee chair for the selected activities.
