

Explanation of Escrow

All choir families who are Booster members at any level, have the opportunity to earn money for their student's escrow account.

The escrow funds earned can be used towards choir fees, competition fees, senior solo arrangements and the bi-annual international choir trip. There are several ways to earn escrow: 1) The "Shop with Scrip Program"; 2) Business Ad sales; 3). Selling above the minimum amount of coupon books; 4). Bringing on a patron for the Patron Program.

Escrow accounts may continue to increase for the term that the student is enrolled in the choral program. Any funds remaining in escrow upon a students' graduation from high school or severance from the choral program may be rolled-over to a younger family member entering the choral program in a consecutive year or will be allocated to the Boosters Financial Assistance Fund for future choir students who are in need of financial assistance.
