Kit Delivery and Hair/Makeup Workshop:

Students will attend a workshop in the Choir Room on OCTOBER 3rd at 7:00pm. Here the girls will see what this year's Choir Looks will be. They will learn how to do their own hair and makeup and pick up their Kits.

Parents are also welcome to join the workshop if they'd like to learn how to recreate the looks to help at home and/or support on performance days.

Replacement Items:

I will always carry replacement items to call times and when traveling to competitions. Most students will go through a couple pair of tights per season and a couple sets of false eye lashes, lose a barrette or an earring, etc...

Rhinestone Earrings Note:

Earrings are purchased as part of the Kit when your student enters choir. We will provide new earrings when a performer changes groups. We will replace earrings if they break. Girls must buy replacements if they lose their earrings during a season.

Additional items your student will need to be performance ready by the first show of the year, Fall Showcase:

Hair:

- Big Sexy Hair brand Hairspray **Note: Whatever brand of hair spray you purchase, for best results, make sure that water is <u>NOT</u> the first ingredient.
- Hair Brush
- Regular Bobbie Pins (these come in different lengths and please match your hair color)
- Large Roller Pins (these are long, thick, flat, bobbie pins)

Makeup:

- Foundation
- Concealer
- Translucent Powder
- Black Mascara
- Black eyeliner (felt-tip liner works well)

***Students must bring the below items to the Hair/Makeup Workshop on 10/3. They will need these items to participate and learn how to do their hair and makeup.

Deodorant**Deodorant - Best to have extra deodorant in your makeup container or caboodle. Girls will reapply often to avoid

unpleasant body odor when rehearsing and performing. It gets hot and sweaty under the stage lights!

We recommend a box, caboodle, or designated bag to keep their choir hair, makeup, accessories, etc. organized and accounted for. Many of the girls use this:

A portable make up mirror can also be a helpful tool. Especially for competitions. Many of the girls use something like this:



Shoes: Tan 2" Heel Character Shoes: Required for South Singers Women. These may be purchased locally at Fancy Dancers or online.

Long Line Bra: ***ALL GIRLS***must wear a long line bra under their costumes. It is the proper under garment for costume fit, creates a polished look, and provides coverage for the ladies when completely private changing areas are not available. Amazon.com Felina Longline Smooth is a good one. Please purchase whatever brand you prefer in natural color without exterior ribbing/bones.
